

The Art & Design Department

The department consists of two full time teachers and a part time technician. Classes are based in two dedicated Art teaching rooms. Sixth form students also have access to an Art Studio for use during their free periods.

The department offers a sequenced and resourced curriculum as well as a lunch time club alongside various competitions and trips. The ideal candidate will need to embrace this ethos as they take on this key role in the team.

In the Lower School, Art & Design is taught to all students in form groups of 30-32 students. They follow a common curriculum, which exposes all students to a range of projects across a variety of media.

A good number of students opt to take Art & Design at both GCSE and A Levels. Due to their exposure to stimulating, active projects, many of them opt to progress to higher education courses that involve Art and/or Design – ranging from Fine Art through to Fashion and Architecture.

The AQA Art & Design (Fine Art) course is followed at both GCSE and A Level.
